- This volume includes Przywara's groundbreaking *Analogia Entis*, originally published in 1932, and his subsequent essays on the concept *analogia entis* — the analogy between God and creation — which has currency in philosophical and theological circles today.
- **Erich Przywara** (1889–1972) was one of the preeminent Catholic theologians of his time who had a profound influence on such people as Hans Urs von Balthasar and Joseph Ratzinger.
